*** Missed stages and Allocated/Derived times** (often these terms are used interchangeably)

Missed a stage and at fault? Then usually you will be given a time that is slowest time in a competition (eg WARC/Clubman) plus 30 seconds. In this calculation, any times of any ineligible/invitational competitors are ignored. NRC SSR 8(g)

If you missed a stage (or failed to complete a stage) and were not at fault? Then you will usually be **allocated** a time by the stewards, a time the stewards consider to be the fairest. Often a time comparable to the fastest on stage compared to other stages; sometimes similar to other competitors when compared to other stages. See NRC 7.10 (c), NRC 7.9 (b) (i) & (iv)

Interesting event results-wise.

- Due to CoViD-19, time cards were supposed to be filled in by competitors.
 - Officials were supposed to let competitors know time and then be shown time card to confirm correct entries
- Unusual activity (of booking cars in late) at a TC caused a few issues. Which was compounded by the need for derived times for SS8. The first few cars were given a 10 second penalty at the end of the event. This was later over-turned the next day.
- Crash on SS8 caused about half of the field to get a valid time, and the rest needed a derived time. Results worked tirelessly to come up with multiple derived times until we achieved a fair outcome. We believed we had on Sunday night. We did not. It was worked on again on Monday and 5 seconds faster than the first run (SS5) was used for the derived times. This was still not ideal for 100% of the competitors, but seemed the fairest overall. Or the most fairest.
- Post-Event, the following error was also picked up and changed:
 - **Car 26:** Removed from 2WD
- Provisional Results were posted, and competitors notified, at 1:00pm Monday 14 September. Allowing 72 hours for any changes or protests.

The Start is Located at TC0/1 in the Harvey Weir Plantation. A route chart from Harvey is in the Road Book. An Official will be on Honeymoon Road to ensure cars arrive at TC0/1 in the correct order.

3.2 CANCELLATION

The organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event if there is insufficient number of entries into the event to cover budget set by Organisers or by reasons of force majeure or safety in accordance with NCR 59 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

3.3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS – CREW CONDUCT

Crews are reminded that normal road traffic rules apply on liaisons. Please be aware that all liaisons are to be treated as quiet zones. Breaches of this regulation will result in penalty.

Competitors are reminded that their behaviour, and that of their service crew, during and after the event is under scrutiny, accordingly anyone seen to be behaving in manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

3.4 SAFETY & PUBLIC RELATIONS ON ROAD SECTIONS

Crews are advised that all road sections are subject to special conditions. This applies to all roads except between the Start line of a Special Stage and the Stop Control located soon after the Flying Finish.

In these sections the following applies:

- 110kph maximum speed limit on sealed (Tarmac) sections of Road (or less depending on road speed limit signs)
- 80kph maximum speed limit on unsealed sections of road (or less depending on road speed limit signs including for road works)
- No vehicle braking or accelerating whatsoever other than as required to safely traverse the road section. No swerving unless for the avoidance of an unexpected hazard.
- No passing or overtaking on unsealed roads except if a vehicle ahead is slowing to stop or turning off the road (such as into spectator points etc.)

Competitors observed taking these actions and reported to the organisers by any Rally Official, Police Officer, Motorsport Australia official or will face the following penalties:

- 1st offence - \$250 fine

- Current Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club Membership Card for Driver and Co-Driver
- Civil Driving licences for both Crew Members (not required if Co-Driver has a navigator only licence)
- Motorsport Australia Vehicle Log Book



- Motorsport Australia Roll Cage Certification Documents
- Homologation Papers and/or Workshop Manual
- Current Vehicle Licence/Permit/Registration Papers

3.6 PRE EVENT SCRUTINY

All Crews are required to attend Scrutiny and Documentation See the Event Programme for Scrutiny Details.

A reminder to Crews that as per the 2020 Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series 2020 Season Standing Regulations, Item G3 (iv), any vehicle that has not yet had a thorough pre-season inspection, including underbody, must either attend Metro Scrutiny or contact the Organisers/Scrutineers to arrange to have their vehicle inspected on a hoist prior to the event.

***Please Note:** Country Scrutiny is **only** available for Competitors who do not live in the Metropolitan Area (defined as the area within a 45km radius of the Perth GPO).

Crews must have accepted the Motorsport Australia disclaimer prior to the Crew being permitted to commence reconnaissance or starting the Event (Clubman Crews).

3.7 POST EVENT SCRUTINY

As per Event Programme

3.8 VEHICLE PRESENTATION

Vehicles when presented for scrutiny must be in a clean condition. There must be no mud or dust on any of the coachwork, engine area, wheel arches or under body of the vehicle. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Vehicles fitted with a turbocharger when presented for scrutiny must be presented with cold turbochargers. Turbochargers should also be drilled ready for turbo sealing.

All Event Signage (including series and event sponsor stickers) must be applied prior to the vehicle being presented to scrutiny. It is recommended that Pre-event Documentation, where you can obtain event signage, is completed prior to presenting to scrutiny

3.9 HELMET AND CLOTHING SCRUTINY

Competitors are advised that the Scrutineer will inspect Crews clothing, footwear and helmets during Pre-event scrutiny. All such items should be presented at this time. All Crew apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

3.10 VEHICLES WITHDRAWING FROM RALLY

Any vehicle withdrawing from the event, and in particular damaged vehicles, must present the vehicle to the Scrutineer, or their nominated representative, before leaving the event location.

3.11 SAFETY - DISPLACING COURSE MARKERS

Crews are advised that if they displace any course markers (e.g. Bunting Tape, Mesh, Plastic Delineators, Caution Board, Corner Markers etc.) during the stage (e.g. Overshooting a corner or intersection) that they **MUST** provide specific details, including the location of the course markers, to the Officials at the next Stop Control. Failure to provide details will result in referral to the Stewards for consideration of a penalty.

3.12 SAFETY – STOPPING ON STAGE (OK / SOS BOARD)

Crews are advised that if they stop during a Special Stage that they **MUST** safely display their Safety Triangles and the OK / SOS Sign to following Crews. This is particularly important where the vehicle is not readily visible to following Crews (e.g. Vehicle is located well off the course on a side road). Failure to display Safety Triangles and/or the OK / SOS Sign will result in referral to the Stewards for consideration of a penalty.



4 AGENCIES INDEMNITIES

Representatives of the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA), Forest Products Commission (FPC), Local Authorities, Department of Water (DOW) and the Water Corporation (WC) have not inspected the route or adjacent roads and cannot guarantee that the roads are or will be suitable and safe for the purpose of the rally.

Accordingly, each person uses the roads entirely at his or her own risk.

5 RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a **Judge of Fact** in relation to vehicle speed and location.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny.

The Rallysafe wiring loom **MUST** be fitted to a fused CONSTANT 12V Power Supply (i.e. not a source that turns off with the ignition)

6 TIMING & RESULTS

The Rallysafe system will be utilised for timing & results during the event.

Provisional results will be posted 30 minutes after last car finishes on the Official Notice Board.

7 AWARDS

7.1 TROPHIES

Trophies shall be awarded in accordance with section H4 of the current WARC SSR

7.2 PRESENTATION

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Programme immediately after the event.

Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after last Clubman Cup crew finish.

WARC awards presentation will occur after last WARC crew finish

8 RE-JOINING THE RALLY

Any car unable to continue to follow the route for any reason will be able to re-join the event in accordance with section G10 of the current WARC SSR and will be eligible to be classified in the results. Series points are allocated as per H6 of the current WARC SSR.

9 SERVICING & REFUELLING

Servicing regulations will be as per Motorsport Australia Australian Rally Championship Sporting & Technical Regulations, Section 16, Traffic and Repairs (Servicing).

The service park for the event will be located as shown in the Event Program and the Service Park Map

Outside of this defined service park any repairs or intervention on the vehicles may only be carried out by the crew, using only such equipment carried on board that competitor's vehicle. No external assistance of any kind is permitted.



Competitors who service outside the defined Service Parks or who receive External Assistance will be excluded from the event.

Registration of two (2) service vehicles is included per competing vehicle. All service vehicles must display their red service number. If no number is displayed they will be asked to leave the service park and park outside the service area.

Registration of up to eight (8) Service crew is included per competing vehicle. Additional service vehicles and service crew may be registered for an additional fee (\$50).

Registration of Service crew is via the online entry system (see www.rallywa.com), or alternative means provided by the Organisers upon request, and must be completed prior to the Drivers Briefing. Service Crew NOT registered will not be eligible for Motorsport Australia Insurance.

All servicing will be conducted in the area shown on attached map. Servicing is to be on a tarpaulin or similar ground sheet and must be placed under the competition vehicle extending beyond the perimeter of the vehicle. All mud and liquids must be placed in sealed containers and removed from the service park. Non-compliance will result in a report to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

A penalty will be applied for any damage to property in the service area equivalent to cost incurred to repair.

Please Note: Competitors, crews, officials and spectators are reminded of their obligations and responsibilities with regard to Western Australian Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, including but not limited to safety when working under raised vehicles, working with compressed air and electrical equipment including tagging of appliances etc.

9.1 REFUELLING

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual

Refuelling must be carried out in the defined refuel area located immediately after the service park exit control; no refuelling is permitted within the service park area.

Conditions of Refuelling are:



- 9.1.1 Up to two Service Crew members per competing vehicle will be permitted into the refuel zone.
- 9.1.2 Road side refuelling is not permitted at any time.
- 9.1.3 Electric fuel pumps used to refuel must comply with the relevant Standards Australia standard for pumping the specific fuels.
- 9.1.4 Fuel shall be stored in the refuel zone during the operation of the Service Park. Fuel containers must be labelled to identify which competitors they belong to.
- 9.1.5 Fuel containers shall be stored in 'shade' and not in direct sunlight. Eg under a marquee or other suitable shelter where natural cover is not available.
- 9.1.6 Decanting of fuel between containers may only be done in a refuel zone or bunded storage area.
- 9.1.7 Any action inside a refuel zone not directly involved in the refuelling of the competing vehicle is prohibited.
- 9.1.8 In all refuel zones, a 5km/h speed limit applies.
- 9.1.9 The Organisers strongly recommend refuelling from a closed hand pump system. The responsibility for refuelling is incumbent on the crew alone and must be done in a manner which ensures that no fuel is spilt.
- 9.1.10 Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation.
- 9.1.11 It is recommended that the Crew remain outside the car during refuelling; however, should they remain inside, the safety belts must be unfastened and door open.
- 9.1.12 The Organisers recommend that all Service Personnel wear neck to wrist to ankle fire resistant clothing, balaclava and fire resistant gloves, all to an appropriate standard, during refuelling.
- 9.1.13 It is also recommended that an anti-static/grounding strap be connected between any fuel containers and the vehicle being refuelled.
- 9.1.14 In the Event of a breakdown, the car concerned may be pushed out of the refuel zone by the crew members, officials and team members without incurring any penalty. An external battery may be used immediately before the exit of the refuel zone away from any refuelling activities.
- 9.1.15 Any breaches of the refuel Regulations, including refuelling outside of designated Refuel Zones; Supplementary Refuel Zones or pumps at Service Stations, will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

Competitors with turbochargers are reminded of the requirements of fuel testing equipment as outlined in Appendix F of the current WARC SSR. Fuel testing may occur and it is the competitor's responsibility to provide the fittings and hose required in order for a fuel sample to be safely obtained.

9.2 SERVICE PARK CONTROLS

Time controls will be set up at the entry and exit to all services parks. The time allowed for service will be indicated in the road book. Liaisons to and from the Service Park do not form part of the service time provided.

Section times have been made long enough to not require the need for excessive speed.

Normal penalties will apply for late or early arrival at these controls.



9.3 SERVICE PARK SPEED LIMIT

The area used for the Service Park is a shared use space and all vehicles entering the area are to adhere to a 10kms per hour (walking pace) speed limit. Any crew deemed to breach this speed limit may be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

All crews associated with the event are required to follow the instructions and advice of the Service Park Officials, failure to do so may result in referral to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of a penalty.

10 RECONNAISSANCE

10.1 PASSES FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Crews will be issued with a pass covering each stage and valid for two (2) passages over the course. This pass must be presented to and endorsed by an official at the start of each Special Stage during reconnaissance.

10.2 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Each reconnaissance vehicle will be provided with a number to be placed in the top left corner of the front windscreen for the purposes of identification when in the forest. These numbers must be affixed to the vehicle for the entire duration of reconnaissance.

10.3 SPEEDS WHILST ON RECONNAISSANCE

The maximum speed limit applicable on all unsealed competition roads during reconnaissance shall be 60km/h and all crews are required to strictly adhere to this limit. Under NO circumstances are crews to travel in the opposite direction to the set course. Please be aware that all Liaisons are to be treated as quiet zones.

On all unsealed liaisons a maximum speed limit of 80km/hr unless the posted speed limit is lower, in which case the lower limit will apply.

10.4 USE OF SPEED MEASURING DEVICES ON RECONNAISSANCE

The speed of the vehicles being used for reconnaissance may be monitored by Officials using Speed Cameras and/or Radar guns. If a vehicle is deemed to be exceeding the reconnaissance speed limit Drivers MUST stop when indicated to by an Official or upon seeing a Red Flag or "STOP" sign. Drivers exceeding the Speed Limit during the Event, including during reconnaissance, will be referred to the Stewards of the meeting for consideration of a penalty.

10.5 ROADS WILL NOT BE CLOSED

During reconnaissance, roads will NOT be closed and crews are advised that they do NOT have priority over other road users. Officials may still be setting up barriers and bunting and members of the public may also be using these roads and may be travelling in the opposing direction to rally traffic.

10.6 ROAD TRAFFIC RULES REMAIN IN FORCE

Crews are also advised that the Road Traffic Act will remain in effect for the duration of reconnaissance and that all road rules must be observed (e.g. complying with advisory signs, obeying speed limits imposed and keeping to the left). Officials will be on course to police these regulations.

10.7 TIME FOR RECONNAISSANCE

As per Event Programme.

10.8 VEHICLES ALLOWED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance may be carried out in any road-registered vehicle. Advertising, under body protection, safety equipment and internal navigational aids are permitted.

10.9 TYRES USED ON RECONNAISSANCE

The tyres to be used are to have a maximum groove width and depth of 8mm and no other opening in the tread may be greater than 12mm (worn rally tyres are **not** to be used). Tyres marked M+S having a non-aggressive tread pattern may be used.



10.10 ACCESS TO COURSE BY CREWS PRIOR TO RECONNAISSANCE

Any member of the crew found on the course in the period two (2) months prior to the start of the rally, with the exception of the period allowed for reconnaissance as per these regulations and any authorised use, will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

11 USE OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

12 SOS SIGN

All competitors are reminded that there is to be a laminated SOS sign contained in the competition vehicle. These will be available at Documentation & Scrutiny.

13 ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check location will be advised in a Bulletin.

14 EVENT SIGNAGE

Each competing vehicle shall attach the event signage supplied by the organisers as shown in Appendix L of the current WARC SSR. The supplied event signage (including Door Card) is NOT to be modified in any way other than as allowed for in the WARC SSR.

Vehicles that do not have the series or event signage correctly fitted for the entire duration of the event may be referred to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

15 PROTEST

Protest must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR's in the current Motorsport Australia Manual.



Ex-WRC stages ready for Make Smoking History Forest Rally

The Make Smoking History Forest Rally has competitors raring to go, starting on one of the old Rally Australia stages near Harvey before moving towards Collie on Sunday 13th September 2020.

Usually a round of the Australian Rally Championship national competition, changes have had to be made due to COVID, which sees the Make Smoking History Forest Rally and the Experts Cup held concurrently as part of the Motorsport Australia WA State Championship.

Rally Australia was a round of the World Rally Championship (WRC) and last held in Perth in 2006, attracting the world's best drivers who competed on some of the best rally roads in the State.

Clerk of Course Ross Tapper said that although this year's Make Smoking History Forest Rally has a compacted format, it's a course that has drivers excited.

"Arguably, the stages around Wellington Dam and the old Rally Australia stages of Harvey Weir, Brunswick and Wellington are some of the best rally stages in WA, if not Australia," Mr Tapper said.

"The famous ball-bearing gravel adds an extra level of complexity for drivers, it's like trying to control a car driving at speed on thousands of marbles."

Competitors will race the clock along 140 kilometres of flat out competition on eight closed road Special Stages including a mammoth 31-kilometre stage around Wellington Dam and travel a total distance of almost 300 kilometres.

A rally differs from other forms of motorsport in that the cars do not compete on a 'circuit' instead they compete on closed road sections that they have only driven over twice in order to make their 'pace notes', a short-hand system of symbols that enables the co-driver to describe to the driver what lies ahead, hides around the next corner or over a blind crest.

During a rally, drivers may only see a particular corner four times and given that the gravel conditions will be different each time with the traversing of a field of competitors, it can be argued that rally drivers are the most skilled of all motorsport competitors.

The Make Smoking History Forest Rally is free for spectators and there are dedicated spectator points for the best vantage points to watch the rally action. Get a close look at rally cars in the Service Park based in the centre of Collie and see how crews miraculously fix huge mechanical problems in record time.

Big local field for Make Smoking History Forest Rally

Forty-six local gravel rally competitors are ready to race the clock at the Make Smoking History Forest Rally on Sunday 13th September 2020 taking place near Harvey and Collie, south-west of Perth.

The Forest Rally has been run since 1983 and part of the Australian Rally Championship (ARC) national competition since 1985, with this year being an exception due to restrictions surrounding COVID-19.

Clerk of Course Ross Tapper said that Western Australia is the only state that has run a round of the ARC continuously since 1974 (different rallies to the Forest Rally).

"Only a pandemic has stopped us from having a national rally," Tapper said.

"The pandemic means we've had to make other changes that include running the Make Smoking History Forest Rally and the Experts Cup at the same time as part of the Motorsport Australia WA State Championship.

"It hasn't stopped local competitors though, we have a strong field who are excited to be driving along some of the former World Rally Championship stages that were used when Rally Australia was held in WA, the last time it was held here was in 2006."

Leading the State Championship after the first round, Bakers Hill, is John O'Dowd and co-driver Toni Feaver in their WRC2 spec Truck Wholesale WA Skoda Fabia R5. In the past, the power of the R5 has seen O'Dowd significantly faster than his rivals, but this time he's got competition.

"At Bakers Hill, Craig Rando and Ben Searcy were quick and closing the gap, but throw in Nic Box, Mike Young and a big field and I reckon there'll be lot of competition, which is the way I like it, and it should make for a good rally," O'Dowd said.

"My strategy is just to be on it from the start, write a good set of notes and commit to them, and hopefully the speed will come.

"I'm looking forward to it, the roads are good, and I like the Wellington Dam stages."

Perth-based New Zealander Mike Young and co-driver Scott Beckwith will be ones to watch in their Maximum Motorsport Subaru WRX STI.

Young by name and young in age at just 27, Mike Young is a nine-year veteran in the Asia Pacific Rally Championship, driving for Japanese team, Cusco Racing. A regular on the podium, Young has finished runner-up in the APRC four times and was crowned Asia Cup Champion last year and also in 2013.

"I'm feeling fairly confident, although I haven't rallied since October last year, and I don't know these roads, but the good thing is that some of the stages are new, which should help," Young said.

“I’ve not tested this car, but I’ve driven a very similar car in the Asia Pacific, it’ll be like riding a bike.

“I’m itching to get back out there after a long break and I’m sick of watching everyone else have fun, so I had to get out there and do it myself. I can’t wait,” he said.

Returning to rallying are former State Champions Doug Tostevin and co-driver Tammy Adams in their 1992 Subaru Liberty RS, the duo likely to shake up the front end of the field.

In the 2WD, competition is expected to be fierce between Nic Box and co-driver in Daymon Nicoli in their Alistar Garage Nissan Silvia S13, Glenn Alcorn and Jonathan Charlesson in their BMG Autos Ford Escort MK2, husband and wife Razvan and Ioana Vlad in their MAXYRally Ford Fiesta, Mike Joss and Megan Logue in their Mike Joss Racing Nissan Silvia S15, and Mick Steele and Katie Oxley in their NATRAD Malaga Nissan Silvia S13.

Carrying a famous rallying name, sixteen-year-old rookie Max McRae will be with experienced co-driver Bill Hayes in their Dirtfish Ford Fiesta ST150, hoping to finish his first State Championship rally.

In the Clubman Cup, Alex and Lisa White in their Information Proficiency Nissan Silvia S13 are favourites however Rod Fowler and co-driver Keith Mayes in their Sussan Fowler Peugeot 206 GTI and Able Tuckett and Glenn Macneal, WA’s most decorated co-driver having competed in over 100 WRC rallies, are likely to be making a charge for the top step in their Humble Bee Finance Hyundai Lantra.

Competitors will tackle 140 kilometres of flat out competition on eight closed road Special Stages including a mammoth 31-kilometre stage around Wellington Dam, travelling a total distance of almost 300 kilometres.

Tight battle on epic stages in perfect conditions – Make Smoking History Forest Rally

In near perfect conditions, 46 local gravel rally competitors ripped through some of Australia's best rally stages yesterday (13th September 2020) for the Make Smoking History Forest Rally near Harvey and Collie, south-west of Perth.

After a chilly start with some low morning fog, the sun came out and the crowds flocked. There was enough moisture in the soil to keep dust low and give the roads grip, which competitors seem to relish.

In the WA Rally Championship, it was a tight battle with four different leaders throughout the rally, three stage winners, and loads of sideways action and dirt being flung that kept hundreds of spectators entertained. The ex World Rally Championship stages that were used for Rally Australia were a hit with drivers and spectators alike.

Competitors tackled 135 kilometres of flat out competition on eight closed road Special Stages including a mammoth 32-kilometre stage around Wellington Dam that was run twice, and travelled a total distance of almost 300 kilometres.

The last two stages saw nine retirements, most of which were mechanical failures besides a major non-critical incident on the final stage where a driver and co-driver were taken to Fiona Stanley Hospital for precautionary checks.

Of the 46 starters, 36 completed the Make Smoking History Forest Rally.

WARC

It was closely fought battle in the WARC that was won by the narrowest of margins. Perth-based New Zealander Mike Young and co-driver Scott Beckwith won four of the eight stages to take the win in their Maximum Motorsport Subaru WRX STI just half a second (0.5 second) ahead of John O'Dowd and co-driver Toni Feaver in their WRC2 spec Truck Wholesale WA Skoda Fabia R5.

Rounding out the top three 1:08 minutes behind O'Dowd was Ben Searcy and co-driver James Marquet in their Swift Motorsport Mitsubishi Lancer.

Young, 27, is no stranger to the podium or tough competition having won two Asia Cups and having finished runner up four times in the Asia Pacific Rally Championship.

"It was a big battle all day and it's always good when a rally is being fought until the last stage," Young said.

"Between myself, John (O'Dowd) and Ben (Searcy), we kept each other honest and kept pushing each other, each trading times, which made us all drive a bit faster.

"The stages were awesome, in great condition and super smooth, it was really enjoyable."

It was the first time Young had driven the Maximum Motorsport prepared WRX, and it was the first win for his co-driver Scott Beckwith.

"The car ran smoothly, Maximum Motorsport produced a good car, it was great to drive all day," he said.

"I took it easy to start with, the first stage I was little slow and as I got more comfortable in the car and more confident, I started pushing a bit more.

"Ross and his team do an awesome job organising the rally, the choice of stages was a good mix and really enjoyable to drive."

Usually the power of the R5 sees O'Dowd significantly faster than his rivals and he still showed pace winning three of the rally's

eight stages.

“The first two stages were slow, maybe I need time to warm up. We got on it and were 20 seconds or so in front of Mike (Young) going into the seventh, and we came across a car that went off, which put me off and I overshot a corner and lost 24 seconds, that’s not an excuse, it’s just what happened,” O’Dowd said.

“The stages were excellent and I enjoyed the battle with Mike (Young) and Ben (Searcy). The car ran perfectly, Toni (Feaver, co-driver) and Race Torque did a magnificent job as always.”

Third-placed Searcy started off with a cracking pace and was leading the rally after the second and third stages but was unable to maintain the lead and keep pace with Young and O’Dowd.

The first stage of the day was won by Peter Major and Declan Stafford but their glory was short-lived as they rolled on the second stage, forcing their retirement.

2WD

In the 2WD, Nic Box and his new co-driver Daymon Nicoli were quickest on every stage taking a clean sweep to win convincingly by 3:14 minutes in their Alistar Garage Nissan Silvia S13 ahead of Michael Joss and Megan Logue in their Mike Joss Racing Nissan Silvia S15.

Rounding out the top three a further 1:25 minutes behind was 16-year-old rookie and learner driver Max McRae and co-driver Bill Hayes in their Dirtfish Ford Fiesta ST150. After McRae’s debut at Bakers Hill which resulted in a DNF, it was great to see the youngster finish his first rally and take his first step onto the podium.

Box said that entering the Make Smoking History Forest Rally was a last-minute decision.

“I didn’t do any preparation as I had just got back from a fishing trip the day before the rally, I hooked up the trailer, got some fuel and went racing, and the car was perfect, no issues at all,” he said.

“The stages were some of WA’s best roads ever, it’d be great to drive on them more often.

“The rally was perfect in every way – perfect weather, perfect stages, perfect car, perfect organisation, the only thing that wasn’t perfect was my co-driver, but I gave him a hard time and did what any self-respecting driver would do, which was 90 per cent of

the effort while he put in 10 per cent, just enough for me to get the job done!” quipped Box.

As well as taking title honours in the 2WD category, Box / Nicoli finished fifth outright.

Usually one of the front runners in the 2WD, Razvan Vlad and his co-driver and wife Ioana had an off on the first stage, which looked like it was going to force a retirement, but they managed to rejoin in the sixth stage.

“It took us a while to dig the car out which only sustained cosmetic damage – bumper, lights, panels, so we missed the first five stages and rejoined after the service – I’m just sorry we didn’t get to drive on the first two stages which were really nice,” Vlad said.

Winning two out of two rallies in the Clubman Cup category was Abe Tuckett and Australia’s most decorated co-driver, Glenn Macneall in their Humble Bee Finance Hyundai Excel. In second place, 3:06 minutes behind were rookies Glenn Cawood and Murish O’Connell in their Shedforce Mitsubishi Lancer. Rounding out the top three was Bruce Lake and Peter Hall in their Carol Lake Datsun 240Z.
