If you missed a stage (or failed to complete a stage) and were not at fault? Then you will usually be **allocated** a time by the stewards, a time the stewards consider to be the fairest. Often a time comparable to the fastest on stage compared to other stages; sometimes similar to other competitors when compared to other stages. See NRC 7.10 (c), NRC 7.9 (b) (i) & (iv)

Interesting event results-wise.

- Technical issues with timing systems meant a delay in some results – many thanks to all who rallied to fix these as quick as possible
- No derived times to work out meant we could look in to things like penalties and late time – fun!
- Post-Event, the following “admin” error was also picked up and changed:
 - **Car 18:** Penalty wrongly imposed for 2 ten seconds penalties – should have been 2 minutes
 - **Car 18:** Re-checking after confirming with a Results Team member, the words were wrong, not the times – these were reversed, and words amended
- Post-Event, on Monday, Car 11 was excluded for breach of NCR 39C Outside Assistance towing car greater than 200m while in liaison from end SS4 to TC4A, as directed by the Clerk of Course, after investigation.

The Results Team really appreciates the assistance of all competitors and officials.

1.9 CANCELLATION

The organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event if there is insufficient number of entries into the event to cover budget set by Organisers or by reasons of force majeure or safety in accordance with NCR 59 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

1.10 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS – CREW CONDUCT

Crews are reminded that normal road traffic rules apply on liaisons. Please be aware that all liaisons are to be treated as quiet zones. Breaches of this regulation will result in penalty.

Competitors are reminded that their behaviour, and that of their service crew, during and after the event is under scrutiny, accordingly anyone seen to be behaving in manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

1.11 SAFETY & PUBLIC RELATIONS ON ROAD SECTIONS

Crews are advised that all road sections are subject to special conditions. This applies to all roads except between the Start line of a Special Stage and the Stop Control located soon after the Flying Finish.

In these sections the following applies:

- 100kph maximum speed limit on sealed (Tarmac) sections of Road (or less depending on road speed limit signs)
- 80kph maximum speed limit on unsealed sections of road (or less depending on road speed limit signs including for road works)
- No vehicle braking or accelerating whatsoever other than as required to safely traverse the road section. No swerving unless for the avoidance of an unexpected hazard.
- No passing or overtaking on unsealed roads except if a vehicle ahead is slowing to stop or turning off the road (such as into spectator points etc.)

Competitors observed taking these actions and reported to the organisers by any Rally Official, Police Officer or Motorsport Australia official will face the following penalties:

- 1st offence - \$250 fine
- 2nd offence – 1 minute time penalty
- 3rd offence – Exclusion from the event and/or results

These penalties will be applied by the Clerk of the Course as soon as possible after the report. Crews will then have the option to lodge a protest with the Stewards of the event, however the penalties will apply until such time as the Stewards or Motorsport Australia's normal judicial processes deem otherwise.



1.12 SCRUTINY

Competitors are reminded that in accordance with NCR 67, they must present the following items to the pre-event documentation check:

- Motorsport Australia Licence for Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver (CR/CRN licence or superior)
- Current Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club Membership Card for Driver and Co-Driver
- Civil Driving licences for both Crew Members (not required if Co-Driver has a navigator only licence)
- Motorsport Australia Vehicle Log Book
- Motorsport Australia Roll Cage Certification Documents
- Homologation Papers and/or Workshop Manual
- Current Vehicle Licence/Permit/Registration Papers

1.13 PRE EVENT SCRUTINY

All Crews are required to attend Scrutiny and Documentation See the Event Programme for Scrutiny Details.

A reminder to Crews that as per the 2020 Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series 2020 Season Standing Regulations, Item G3 (iv), any vehicle that has not yet had a thorough pre-season inspection, including underbody, must either attend Metro Scrutiny or contact the Organisers/Scrutineers to arrange to have their vehicle inspected on a hoist prior to the event.

***Please Note:** Country Scrutiny is **only** available for Competitors who do not live in the Metropolitan Area (defined as the area within a 45km radius of the Perth GPO). WARC Competitors who need to represent or are doing country Documentation will need to have their Service Crew available for this, as they will be out on **RECONNAISSANCE** at the time of Scrutineering.

Crews must have accepted the Motorsport Australia disclaimer prior to the Crew being permitted to commence reconnaissance or starting the Event (Clubman Crews).

1.14 POST EVENT SCRUTINY

Will be held as per Event Programme

1.15 VEHICLE PRESENTATION

Vehicles when presented for scrutiny must be in a clean condition. There must be no mud or dust on any of the coachwork, engine area, wheel arches or under body of the vehicle. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Vehicles fitted with a turbocharger when presented for scrutiny must be presented with cold turbochargers. Turbochargers should also be drilled ready for turbo sealing.

All Event Signage (including series and event sponsor stickers) must be applied prior to the vehicle being presented to scrutiny. It is recommended that Pre-event Documentation, where you can obtain event signage, is completed prior to presenting to scrutiny

1.16 HELMET AND CLOTHING SCRUTINY

Competitors are advised that the Scrutineer will inspect Crews clothing, footwear and helmets during Pre-event scrutiny. All such items should be presented at this time. All Crew apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

1.17 VEHICLES WITHDRAWING FROM RALLY

Any vehicle withdrawing from the event, and in particular damaged vehicles, must present the vehicle to the Scrutineer, or their nominated representative, before leaving the event location.

1.18 SAFETY - DISPLACING COURSE MARKERS

Crews are advised that if they displace any course markers (e.g. Bunting Tape, Mesh, Plastic Delineators, Caution Board, Corner Markers etc.) during the stage (e.g. Overshooting a corner or intersection) that they **MUST** provide specific details, including the location of the course markers, to the Officials at the next Stop Control. Failure to provide details will result in referral to the Stewards for consideration of a penalty.



1.19 SAFETY – STOPPING ON STAGE (OK / SOS BOARD)

Crews are advised that if they stop during a Special Stage that they **MUST** safely display their Safety Triangles and the OK / SOS Sign to following Crews. This is particularly important where the vehicle is not readily visible to following Crews (e.g. Vehicle is located well off the course on a side road). Failure to display Safety Triangles and/or the OK / SOS Sign will result in referral to the Stewards for consideration of a penalty.

AGENCIES INDEMNITIES

Representatives of the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA), Forest Products Commission (FPC), Local Authorities, Department of Water (DOW) and the Water Corporation (WC) have not inspected the route or adjacent roads and cannot guarantee that the roads are or will be suitable and safe for the purpose of the rally.

Accordingly, each person uses the roads entirely at his or her own risk.

RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a **Judge of Fact** in relation to vehicle speed and location.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny.

The Rallysafe wiring loom **MUST** be fitted to a fused CONTSTANT 12V Power Supply (i.e. not a source that turns off with the ignition)

TIMING & RESULTS

The Rallysafe system will be utilised for timing & results during the event.

Provisional results will be posted 30 minutes after last car finishes on the Official Notice Board. These results will become Final 72 hours after posting subject to no protests being received.

Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of NCR.

AWARDS

1.20 TROPHIES

Trophies shall be awarded in accordance with section H4 of the current WARC SSR

1.21 PRESENTATION

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Programme immediately after the event.

Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after last Clubman Cup crew finish.

WARC awards presentation will occur after last WARC crew finish

RE-JOINING THE RALLY

Any car unable to continue to follow the route for any reason will be able to re-join the event in accordance with section G10 of the current WARC SSR and will be eligible to be classified in the results. Series points are allocated as per H6 of the current WARC SSR.



SERVICING & REFUELLING

Servicing regulations will be as per Motorsport Australia Australian Rally Championship Sporting & Technical Regulations, Section 16, Traffic and Repairs (Servicing).

The service park for the event will be located at the old hockey grounds, Rutherford Street Manjimup. See service park map for approved areas.

Outside of this defined service park any repairs or intervention on the vehicles may only be carried out by the crew, using only such equipment carried on board that competitor's vehicle. No external assistance of any kind is permitted.

Competitors who service outside the defined Service Parks or who receive External Assistance will be excluded from the event.

Registration of two (2) service vehicles is included per competing vehicle. All service vehicles must display their red service number. If no number is displayed they will be asked to leave the service park and park outside the service area.

Registration of eight (8) Service crew is included per competing vehicle. Additional service vehicles and service crew may be registered for an additional fee (\$50).

Registration of Service crew is via the online entry system (see www.rallywa.com), or alternative means provided by the Organisers upon request, and must be completed prior to the Drivers Briefing. Service Crew NOT registered will not be eligible for Motorsport Australia Insurance. Refer to Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook Article 7.2

All servicing will be conducted in the area shown on attached map. Servicing is to be on a tarpaulin or similar ground sheet and must be placed under the competition vehicle extending beyond the perimeter of the vehicle. All mud and liquids must be placed in sealed containers and removed from the service park. Non-compliance will result in a report to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

A penalty will be applied for any damage to property in the service area equivalent to cost incurred to repair.

Please Note: Competitors, crews, officials and spectators are reminded of their obligations and responsibilities with regard to Western Australian Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, including but not limited to safety when working under raised vehicles, working with compressed air and electrical equipment including tagging of appliances etc.



1.22 REFUELLING

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual

Refuelling must be carried out in the defined refuel area located immediately after the service park exit control; no refuelling is permitted within the service park area.

Conditions of Refuelling are:

- 1.22.1 Up to two Service Crew members per competing vehicle will be permitted into the refuel zone.
- 1.22.2 Road side refuelling is not permitted at any time.
- 1.22.3 Electric fuel pumps used to refuel must comply with the relevant Standards Australia standard for pumping the specific fuels.
- 1.22.4 Fuel shall be stored in the refuel zone during the operation of the Service Park. Fuel containers must be labelled to identify which competitors they belong.
- 1.22.5 Fuel containers shall be stored in 'shade' and not in direct sunlight Eg under a marquee or other suitable shelter where natural cover is not available
- 1.22.6 Decanting of fuel between containers may only be done in a refuel zone or bunded storage area.
- 1.22.7 Any action inside a refuel zone not directly involved in the refuelling of the competing vehicle is prohibited.
- 1.22.8 In all refuel zones, a 5km/h speed limit applies.
- 1.22.9 The Organisers strongly recommend refuelling from a closed hand pump system. The responsibility for refuelling is incumbent on the crew alone and must be done in a manner which ensures that no fuel is spilt.
- 1.22.10 Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation.
- 1.22.11 It is recommended that the Crew remain outside the car during refuelling; however, should they remain inside, the safety belts must be unfastened and door open.
- 1.22.12 The Organisers recommend that all Service Personnel wear neck to wrist to ankle fire resistant clothing, balaclava and fire resistant gloves, all to an appropriate standard, during refuelling.
- 1.22.13 It is also recommended that an anti-static/grounding strap be connected between any fuel containers and the vehicle being refuelled.
- 1.22.14 In the Event of a breakdown, the car concerned may be pushed out of the refuel zone by the crew members, officials and team members without incurring any penalty. An external battery may be used immediately before the exit of the refuel zone away from any refuelling activities.
- 1.22.15 Any breaches of the refuel Regulations, including refuelling outside of designated Refuel Zones; Supplementary Refuel Zones or pumps at Service Stations, will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

Competitors with turbochargers are reminded of the requirements of fuel testing equipment as outlined in Appendix F of the current WARC SSR. Fuel testing may occur and it is the competitor's responsibility to provide the fittings required in order for a fuel sample to be obtained.



1.23 SERVICE PARK CONTROLS

Time controls will be set up at the entry and exit to all services parks. The time allowed for service will be indicated in the road book. Liaisons to and from the Service Park do not form part of the service time provided.

Section times have been made long enough to not require the need for excessive speed.

Normal penalties will apply for late or early arrival at these controls.

1.24 SERVICE PARK SPEED LIMIT

The area used for the Service Park is a shared use space and all vehicles entering the area are to adhere to a 10kms per hour (walking pace) speed limit. Any crew deemed to breach this speed limit may be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

All crews associated with the event are required to follow the instructions and advice of the Service Park Officials, failure to do so may result in referral to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of a penalty.

RECONNAISSANCE

1.25 PASSES FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Crews will be issued with a pass covering each stage and valid for two (2) passages over the course.

1.26 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Each reconnaissance vehicle will be provided with a number to be placed in the top left corner of the front windscreen for the purposes of identification when in the forest. These numbers must be affixed to the vehicle for the entire duration of reconnaissance.

1.27 SPEEDS WHILST ON RECONNAISSANCE

The maximum speed limit applicable on all unsealed competition roads during reconnaissance shall be 60km/h and all crews are required to strictly adhere to this limit. Under NO circumstances are crews to travel in the opposite direction to the set course. Please be aware that all Liaisons are to be treated as quiet zones.

On all unsealed liaisons a maximum speed limit of 80km/hr unless the posted speed limit is lower, in which case the lower limit will apply.

1.28 USE OF SPEED MEASURING DEVICES ON RECONNAISSANCE

The speed of the vehicles being used for reconnaissance may be monitored by Officials using Speed Cameras, Radar guns or Rallysafe data. If a vehicle is deemed to be exceeding the reconnaissance speed limit Drivers MUST stop when indicated to by an Official or upon seeing a Red Flag or "STOP" sign. Drivers exceeding the Speed Limit during the Event, including during reconnaissance, will be referred to the Stewards of the meeting for consideration of a penalty.

1.29 ROADS WILL NOT BE CLOSED

During reconnaissance, roads will NOT be closed and crews are advised that they do NOT have priority over other road users. Officials may still be setting up barriers and bunting and members of the public may also be using these roads and may be travelling in the opposing direction to rally traffic.

1.30 ROAD TRAFFIC RULES REMAIN IN FORCE

Crews are also advised that the Road Traffic Act will remain in effect for the duration of reconnaissance and that all road rules must be observed (e.g. complying with advisory signs, obeying speed limits imposed and keeping to the left). Officials will be on course to police these regulations.

1.31 TIME FOR RECONNAISSANCE

As per Event Programme.



1.32 VEHICLES ALLOWED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance may be carried out in any road-registered vehicle. Advertising, under body protection, safety equipment and internal navigational aids are permitted.

1.33 TYRES USED ON RECONNAISSANCE

The tyres to be used are to have a maximum groove width and depth of 8mm and no other opening in the tread may be greater than 12mm (worn rally tyres are **not** to be used). Tyres marked M+S having a non-aggressive tread pattern may be used.

1.34 ACCESS TO COURSE BY CREWS PRIOR TO RECONNAISSANCE

Any member of the crew found on the course in the period two (2) months prior to the start of the rally, with the exception of the period allowed for reconnaissance as per these regulations and any authorised use, will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.

USE OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

SOS SIGN

All competitors are reminded that there is to be a laminated SOS sign contained in the competition vehicle. These will be available at Documentation & Scrutiny.

ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TC0.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

EVENT SIGNAGE

Each competing vehicle shall attach the event signage supplied by the organisers as shown in Appendix L of the current WARC SSR. The supplied event signage (including Door Card) is NOT to be modified in any way other than as allowed for in the WARC SSR.

Vehicles that do not have the series or event signage correctly fitted for the entire duration of the event may be referred to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion or other penalty.



Make Smoking History Karri Rally a crucial round in championship points battle

There are only two more rounds left for WA State Rally Championship and Clubman Cup competitors to gain points before the close of the slightly shortened 2020 WARC season.

This Saturday's Make Smoking History Karri Rally is expected to produce a tight battle on the fast forestry roads in the Nyamup State Forest (east of Manjimup) between the Top 4 outright contenders.

Currently leading the drivers' championship is John O'Dowd who drives the Truck Wholesale WA Skoda R5. Sitting beside O'Dowd is Toni Feaver who is presently leading the co-drivers' championship.

Despite an earlier forecast for rain for the weekend, O'Dowd's wish for clear skies has been granted with current forecasts now predicting good weather.

"Karri is a good rally with some pretty fast roads," said O'Dowd. "We're just hoping for no rain and that the little Skoda has the legs to keep up."

"We're looking forward to a good battle with Mike Young and Ben Searcy again. There should be some close competition throughout the field."

Only 18 points behind O'Dowd on the leaderboard is Ben Searcy who will be driving the Swift Motorsport Mitsubishi Lancer Evo 9 with James Marquet co-driving.

Searcy acknowledged that the quick turnaround between rounds is a consideration during competition.

"The three-week turn around (between Forest Rally and Karri Rally) was not ideal," said Searcy. "But, I'm very fortunate to have a great team of guys who spent last weekend re-preparing the car for this weekend."

"It is something that we knew about before the last event, so it was important that we didn't kill the car at Forest Rally and drove accordingly."

"The roads of Karri Rally are super quick – it was my second rally in the car last year, so it was all very new."

"I'm looking forward to heading back to Manjimup to try and increase the pace to keep up with O'Dowd, Young and Major."

Craig Rando currently occupies third place in the drivers' championship only 6 points behind Searcy, and will be in the Rando Constructions Subaru WRX STI with co-driver Stephen Wade by his side.

Maximum Motorsport driver and Forest Rally round winner Mike Young occupies fourth place going into Karri. Young's co-driver Scott Beckwith is currently sitting second in the co-drivers' championship.

Leading the 2WD Championship is Glenn Alcorn and co-driver Jonathan Charlesson in the BMG Autos Ford Escort Mk2. They are only 6 points ahead of Michael Joss and Megan Logue in the Mike Joss Racing Nissan S15 Silvia.

Back to back WA Rally Championship Round wins for Young and Beckwith

Fresh off their win three weeks ago at the Forest Rally, Mike Young and co-driver Scott Beckwith has done it again by taking first outright at the Make Smoking History Karri Rally on Saturday.

Young and other WA Rally State Championship (WARC) competitors battled over 116 competitive kilometres on Nyamup State Forest roads close to Manjimup. Conditions were rally perfect on the day, with cool weather and dry

roads.

It was the first time driving the Karri Rally stages for Young, who usually competes in the Asia-Pacific Rally Championship at this time in the year.

The Maximum Motorsport Subaru WRX STI driver and co-driver Beckwith managed to keep WARC leader John O'Dowd and his co-driver Toni Feaver at bay.

"John O'Dowd kept me honest throughout today," said Young. "We had a good battle in the morning, but I managed to pull away towards the end there.

"Before today, I have had people tell me that the stages were fast and I didn't really believe them – but they are!

"The stages were good fun and suited the way I drive. They require a big commitment which I like."

O'Dowd and Feaver crossed the finish line in Truck Wholesale WA Skoda Fabia R5 with only a 1:43 minute gap to the leaders. O'Dowd said he really enjoyed the close competition.

"It was a good battle with Mike," said O'Dowd. "I didn't get anywhere near him but it was excellent racing and I thoroughly enjoyed it. Mike is a great driver and hats off to him and Scott for doing a fantastic job.

"I was really happy with the way I drove today. I'm usually slow out of the blocks, but I improved on that and came out quite strong.

"They were two fast paced stages. A problem the little Skoda has is that it doesn't have the legs for the fast stuff – it's flat out doing 170 kilometres an hour, and I think my previous car was closer to 200km. But that's not what lost the rally for us – the car didn't make any difference."

Ben Searcy and James Marquet rounded out the outright podium in the Swift Motorsport Lancer Evo 9, finishing the event with a 3:23 gap to the leaders.

Second Win in WA Championship for Young and Beckwith

New Zealander Mike Young and co-driver Scott Beckwith took their second win in a row at the 2020 West Australian Rally Championship Karri Rally driving a Maximum Motorsport Subaru Impreza.

After winning the last round, the Forest Rally by just 0.5 seconds, this time it was a more comfortable margin of 1 minute 47 seconds ahead of 2nd place John O'Dowd in a Skoda Fabia R5.

Young and O'Dowd were locked in a tight battle for the first two stages with a win a piece, but after the first service break Young started to edge ahead.

"The Karri Rally stages really suited me, really fast and flowing and where you have to be committed to the notes. A big thanks to Scott and Maximum Motorsport for the car, it ran well all day", said Young at the finish.

Maximum Motorsport team were equally happy "Great event – everything went to plan, no problems or issues with the car and Mike and Scott executed a near perfect rally", said team owner Dean Herridge.

Young's win moves him to 2nd place in the West Australia Rally championship with 160 points, 16 behind current leader O'Dowd.

Although Young is yet to confirm if he will do any further events in the championship, with only one more round to go the Safari Darling Rally on November 7th, O'Dowd only needs to finish second to win the WA championship for a 3rd time.

In the co-driver championship its bit tighter, Beckwith just two points behind O'Dowds co-driver Toni Feaver – if Young can win the final round, Beckwith will win.
