- The National Rally Standing Regulations Vehicles General
- The National Rally Standing Regulations Events General (EG)
- The Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR),
- These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

The event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

The maximum number of entries will be 70, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

The Event Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee will apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

2.2 Event Details

The Official Notice Board will be located on www.rallywa.com and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (See Event Program).

Bonus points will be allocated as per the MAWARCS SSR Article H2 (vi) on SS9.

2.3 Documentation and Scrutiny

All vehicles are to attend scrutineering prior to the event. All competitors shall also complete the Motorsport Australia form TSP03 "Statement of Vehicle Compliance" and Self Scrutiny checklist (Rally) which is required to be presented at documentation.

Competitor documentation (licenses, permits etc) are all to be submitted electronically to grimwade@rallywa.com before close of entries date.

Scrutiny schedule will be posted on the official notice board prior to scrutiny and after entries closed.

Documentation (event stickers and road books) to be collected at scrutiny time by all competitors.

Location and time of documentation and scrutiny are shown in the Event Programme. All documentation must be completed before Scrutineering.

3. RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny. There are available from RallySafe https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact for "Push to Pass" notification.

Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed, location and "Push to Pass" notification.

4. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the event. Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. Clubman to finish after SS8. WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish.

5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A. The Service Park for the event will be located at VC Mitchell Park Donnybrook. Service Vehicles may be parked in the Service Park overnight. The Organisers take no responsibility for the vehicles.
- B. Refuelling is also permitted at both BP and Vibe Service Stations **But must be within Liaison times** (both supply 98 Octane Fuel) There will be only one opportunity to refuel the car. The Refuel will be located within the Service Park. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- C. Remote Refueling will be available at Grimwade-Wilga Road between SS3/SS4 and SS7/SS8 within signposted refuel zone. Enough Fuel will need to be sent for both refuels. Transport of fuel will be offered by the organisers for those who require a fuel drop and fuel containers will be taken back to the Service Park at the completion of the rally. Please ensure that your containers are clearly marked. Fuel to be dropped at the remote fuel location needs to be at the designated collection point on the outside of the regroup area.
- D. Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming into contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied.

 The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" area.
- E. No service vehicle may drive on a competitive stage during the running of the Event without the express permission of the Clerk of the Course. If vehicle recovery is required, service crews are to contact the Competitor Relations Officer or Rally HQ for instruction.

- F. In order to be covered by the Motorsport Australia Personal Accident Insurance, service crew members must be registered with the Organisers by the close of Documentation Verification.
- G. The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" area.

6. RECONNAISSANCE

Times for reconnaissance are shown in the Event Program.

7. ODOMETER CHECK

Will be located on the first liaison section from TCO.

The start of the odometer check can be found on Sandhills Rd. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check

8. PROTEST

Any protests must be in accordance with the NCR.

9. INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

No fires are permitted at any location on the property during the event.

Smoking

VC Mitchell Park is a public open space, and it is preferred that you do not smoke at the venue.

We all have a duty of care to each other, if you see something that is not safe or believe could be an issue, please advise the event organisers immediately.

Alcohol

The service park is a community area (public place) normal local and state laws apply regarding the consumption of alcohol.

Noise

Please be respectful of the people in the area at all times.

Provision of Officials

Competitors are reminded of Appendix 3 of the current Motorsport Australia Western Australia Rally Championship and Series, Season Standing Regulations. The organisers ask that all competitors provide one person to act as an official on the event. Prior Motorsport Australia accreditation is not required for road closure officials, they will be issued a trainee licence on the day. All duties, and responsibilities and authority that are applicable, will be fully explained and supported by documentation.
