1. ORGANISATION

- The Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations Special Stage Rallies (SSR)
- The National Rally Standing Regulations Vehicles General
- The National Rally Standing Regulations Events General (EG)
- The Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR),
- These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

The event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

The maximum number of entries will be 70, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee will apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

2.2 Event Details

See Event Program for Dates and Times. See Itinerary for Distances.

The Official Notice Board will be located on www.rallywa.com and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (See Event Program).

Bonus points will be allocated as per the MAWARCS SSR Article H2 (vi) on SS6.

2.3 Documentation and Scrutiny

Targeted scrutiny will be in place for this event. A list of cars to be scrutineered will be published and competitors advised after entries have closed.

Competitor documentation (licenses, permits etc) are all to be submitted electronically to safari@rallywa.com before close of entries date.

Documentation (event stickers and road books) to be collected at scrutiny time by all competitors.

Location and time of documentation and scrutiny are shown in the Event Programme. All documentation must be completed before Scrutineering.

3. RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny. These are available from RallySafe https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where a penalty may be applied.

Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed, location and "Push to Pass" notification.

4. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the Event. Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. Clubman to finish after SS4. WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish.

5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A. The Service Park for the event will be located at the Chidlow Village Green. See the service park map for approved servicing areas.
- B. Refuelling will be at Chidlow Village Green in the dedicated refuel area only.
- C. Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming into contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards and a penalty may be applied.
- D. No service vehicle may drive on a competitive stage during the running of the Event without the express permission of the Clerk of the Course. If vehicle recovery is required, service crews are to contact the Competitor Relations Officer or Rally HQ for instruction.
- E. In order to be covered by the Motorsport Australia Personal Accident Insurance, service crew members must be registered with the Organisers by the close of Documentation Verification.
- F. The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" (which includes Vaping and E-Cigarettes) area.

6. RECONNAISSANCE

Times for reconnaissance are shown in the Event Program.

7. ODOMETER CHECK

A 1 kilometre odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TCO. The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

8. PROTEST

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

9. ROOKIES

All Rookies should register with the Event Secretary they are eligible for the Rookie Award by emailing safari@rallywa.com.

10. INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

11. DISEASE RISK AREA AND WATER CATCHMENT AREA

Please note the course is conducted within a disease risk area and in the Water Corporation water catchment area. As such there is no prior access available without consent from the organisers. Anyone accessing the area prior to the event could cause event permits to be cancelled. Competitors are reminded not to access the competition roads prior to the event as per the MAWARCS SSR Appendix 1.

12. RESERVOIR PROTECTION ZONE (RPZ)

Please note the course is close to the Reservoir Protection Zone (RPZ) as indicated on stage maps. At no time is anyone allowed into the RPZ. Anyone found in the RPZ will be subject to fines from Water Corporation Rangers and further penalties from the Stewards.

13. POST EVENT FUNCTION AND PRESENTATION

There will be a **FREE** post event function and awards presentation for Clubman Masters, Clubman and WARC competitors at the Chidlow Tavern. This is FREE for drivers and co-drivers and officials of the event. Additional tickets can be purchased for \$15 each by emailing safari@rallywa.com.

Fires

No fires are permitted during the event.

Duty of Care

We all have a duty of care to each other, if you see something that is not safe or believe could be an issue, please advise the event organisers immediately.

Alcohol

The service park is a community area (public place) normal local and state laws apply regarding the consumption of alcohol. Alcohol is available for competitors after the competition at The Chidlow Tavern across from the service park.

Noise

Please be respectful of the people in the area at all times. Liaison on all gravel roads will be monitored by surrounding residents. Anyone reported to be driving recklessly will be referred to the Stewards by the Clerk of the Course.

Provision of Officials

Competitors are reminded of Appendix 3 of the current Motorsport Australia Western Australia Rally Championship and Series, Season Standing Regulations. The organisers ask that all competitors provide one person to act as an official on the event. Prior Motorsport Australia accreditation is not required for road closure officials, they will be issued a trainee licence on the day. All duties, and responsibilities and authority that are applicable, will be fully explained and supported by documentation.
