The Event shall be a State Special Stage Rally incorporating a Club Special Stage Rally held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations - Vehicles General, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations - Special Stage Rallies, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations - Events General, the Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR), these Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

This Event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, Legal and Integrity and Risk Management Policies which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au and the Return to Race Strategy which can be found at: www.motorsport.org.au/COVID-19

The maximum number of entries will be 60, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

As per the NCR's the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee will apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

2.2 Event Details

See Event Program for Dates and Times, See Itinerary for Distances.

The Official Notice Board will be located on www.rallywa.com and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (See Event Program).

Points will be allocated as per the MAWARCS SSR H6 (v) with a factor of 50%. The Bonus Stage as per H6 (vi) will be SS8 TOCOAN, this will be 50% points. For the purposes of the Bonus Stage, a finisher will be deemed any crew that arrives at final control, TC8A. The points will be 5, 3, 2, 1, 0.5 for fastest to fifth fastest on the stage.

2.3 Documentation and Scrutiny

All vehicles are to attend Scrutineering. All documentation must be completed before or at Scrutineering.

All competitors shall complete the Motorsport Australia form TSP03 "Statement of Vehicle Compliance" which is required to be emailed to grimwade@rallywa.com.

Location and time of scrutiny and documentation are shown in the Event Program and a Bulletin showing the location and times for each car will be issued.

3. RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed and location.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny. There are available from RallySafe <https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/>

4. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the event. Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. Clubman to finish after SS8. WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish.

5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A. The Service Park for the event will be located as per the attached map at Egan Park Donnybrook. See Service Park Map for approved areas. Service Vehicles may be parked in the Service Park overnight. The Organisers take no responsibility for the vehicles.
- B. Refueling is also permitted at both BP and Vibe Service Stations **But must be within Liaison times** (both supply 98 Octane Fuel) There will be only one opportunity to refuel the car. The Refuel will be located within the Service Park. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- C. **Remote Refueling** will be available at Grimwade-Wilga Road between SS3/SS4 and SS7/SS8 within signposted refuel zone. Enough Fuel will need to be sent for both refuels. Transport of fuel will be offered by the organisers for those who require a fuel drop and fuel containers will be taken back to the Service Park at the completion of the rally. Please ensure that your containers are clearly marked. **Fuel to be dropped at the remote fuel location needs to be at the designated collection point on the outside of the regroup area**
- D. Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming into contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied. The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" area. Social distancing of 1.5m separation must be adhered to, at all times in the Service Park.

6. RECONNAISSANCE

Times for reconnaissance are shown in the Event Program.

7. ODOMETER CHECK

Will be located on the first liaison section from TCO.

The start of the odometer check can be found on Sandhills Rd. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check

8. PROTEST

Protest must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's in the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

9. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drugs or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded on Sunday 03 April 2022. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (of a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au
